- Rolling- Passing flat bars through rollers to make sheet product
- Blanking- Stamping sheet in a press
- Cupping- Extrusion process using a cupping press
- Drawing- Both Wire and Tube- Passing wire and/tube through dyes and/or arbors achieve required diameters
- Slitting- Cutting of sheet or ribbon to desired widths
